CMS RDA Implementation

- Post-U.S. National Libraries RDA Test
 - 1/1/11-4/1/12 - Creation of original records in RDA optional
 - 4/1/12-present - Original and upgraded records in RDA
- OCLC Policy on RDA (<http://www.oclc.org/us/en/rda/policy.htm>)

RDA Impact on Workflow

- Library Technician : little impact

Familiar with RDA - not fully trained

- Catalogers : medium impact

Initially, a steep learning curve. Less of a curve now—but we're still learning!
At this time, no retrospective conversion of local records

- Costs

Added cost of RDA Toolkit (\$325 per year for online; \$150 for print)

Cost of adding RDA authority records (??? TBD)

Attending workshops and presentations (no change in budget)

Possible system upgrades to accommodate RDA records (??? TBD)
